ORDINANCE NO. C-756-2011

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 8, "REGISTRATION AND LICENSING," ARTICLE I, "REGISTRATION," IN ORDER TO EXTEND THE EFFECT OF A REGISTRATION DURING THE LAST QUARTER OF THE YEAR INTO THE NEXT CALENDAR YEAR AND TO PROVIDE THAT PENALTIES FOR LATE REGISTRATION SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY COUNCIL RESOLUTION.

THE CITY OF FARMINGTON ORDAINS:

Section 1 of Ordinance

That Chapter 8, "Registration and Licensing," Article I, "Registration," Sec. 8-6, "Registration expiration date," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 8-6. Registration expiration date.

The registration year shall terminate on the thirty-first day of December at 12:00 midnight next after the date of registration; provided, however, that if the initial registration occurs during the last quarter of the year (i.e., between the first day of October and the thirty-first day of December) then the registration shall apply to the following calendar year and the registration shall not terminate until the thirty-first day of December of the following year.

Section 2 of Ordinance

That Chapter 8, "Registration and Licensing," Article I, "Registration," Sec. 8-7, "Fees," is hereby amended to read as follows.

Sec. 8-7. Fees.

Each registrant shall pay a fee determined by resolution of city council to be sufficient to pay the costs of maintaining the data secured by the registration program; provided, however, fees paid after the due date shall be subject to penalty as established by city council resolution.

Section 3 of Ordinance Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are repealed only to the extent necessary to give this ordinance full force and effect.

Section 4 of Ordinance Severability.

Should any section, subdivision, clause, or phrase of this ordinance be declared by the courts to be invalid, the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or in part, shall not be affected other than the part invalidated.

Section 5 of Ordinance Savings.

All proceedings pending and all rights and liabilities existing, acquired or incurred at the time this ordinance takes effect are saved and may be consummated according to the law in force when they were commenced.

Section 6 of Ordinance Effective Date.

The provisions of this Ordinance are ordered to take effect following publication in the manner prescribed by the Charter of the City of Farmington.

Section 7 of Ordinance Adoption.

This ordinance is hereby declared to have been adopted by the Farmington City Council in a meeting thereof duly held and called on the 6th day of June, 2011, in order to be given publication in the manner prescribed by the Charter of the City of Farmington.
