#### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

##### Fraud

On July 13<sup>th</sup> an officer was dispatched to the 7-11 on Grand River Ave for a report of a fraud. Upon arrival the officer learned from the owner that an unknown Hispanic male had entered the store on July 12<sup>th</sup> in order to purchase \$1,500 worth of Visa gift cards. The clerk activated 3 cards and then noticed that the suspect had only given him \$1,400. The suspect apologized and gave the gift cards back to the clerk and left with his money. The owner reviewed video of the incident on the 13<sup>th</sup> and noticed that the suspect had pocketed the activated gift cards and returned to the clerk (3) un-activated cards. The case was turned over to the detective bureau for further investigation.

##### Larceny of Bicycle

On July 16<sup>th</sup> a Nine Mile resident reported that an unknown person had stolen a bicycle from the victim's driveway. The bicycle is a Schwinn 29" Taff Mountain Bike, black in color.
