SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Illegal Dumping

On November 9th an officer responded to the Tweeny Party Store on Grand River Ave for a report of someone illegally dumping garbage in the store dumpster. Upon arrival the officer learned from management that a Potomac Cir. Resident has been dumping garbage in the store dumpster without the manager's permission. The officer contacted the person who dumped the trash and they were advised that they would be cited for illegally dumping if they continue to dump without permission.

Odor Investigation

On November 11th officers and Engine 1 responded to the 34000 block of Glenview for an odor of natural gas. Upon arrival officers noted that the odor was not natural gas, but instead was an odor of sewer because the basement water traps had dried out. Officers added water to the pipes and the odor went away.

Carbon Monoxide Alarm

On November 12th Officers and Engine 1 responded to the 34000 block of Schulte for a carbon monoxide alarm activation. Upon arrival officers checked the home and could not find any traces of CO in the building. Officers noted that the CO detector was from 1994 and appeared to be malfunctioning.
