### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### Neighbor Trouble

On September 24<sup>th</sup> an officer was dispatched to the Fresh Thyme Farmers Market for a report of a harassment. Upon arrival, the officer learned from the complainant that the complainant was shopping at the store with his young son when he noticed his neighbor video taping them. The complainant advised that his neighbor has been harassing him and his son and wanted the incident documented.

#### Operate While Intoxicated

On September 25<sup>th</sup> at approximately 7:30 PM an officer stopped a vehicle on Freedom Rd. near Treehill for speeding. Further investigation revealed that the driver exhibited signs of intoxication. The driver failed several sobriety exams and was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated. The driver submitted to a breath test with a result of a .20 BAC. The driver has a prior conviction for OWI and will be charged with the second offence.

#### Trespass Warning Issued

On September 25<sup>th</sup> officers were dispatched to the Pet Valu on Farmington Rd. for a report of an unwanted customer. Upon arrival the manager of the store advised that there is a customer in the store that has been caught shoplifting in the past that the manager believes is attempting to shoplift again. Officers confronted the woman and noted that she did have some items concealed in her purse. Store management declined to press charges but requested that the customer be issued a no trespassing order. The woman was advised that she would be arrested if she returned to the store.



### **Carrying a Concealed Weapon**

On September 25<sup>th</sup> an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Lakeway for an improper lane use violation. Further investigation revealed that the driver had a suspended driver's license and several warrants for his arrest. The driver was arrested and an unregistered firearm was discovered inside his vehicle. The driver was charged with carrying a concealed weapon and driving on a suspended license.

### **Hit and Run Accident**

On September 26<sup>th</sup> officers responded to the area of Grand River Ave and Shiawassee for a report of a hit and run accident. Upon arrival, the victim advised the officer that he had been stopped at the traffic light when he was rear ended by a gray Dodge Charger. After the accident, the driver of the Charger pulled next to the victim, apologized for hitting him, and then fled the scene. The driver of the Charger was located by another officer and she advised that she fled the scene because the victim was getting angry. The driver of the Charger was cited for the hit and run as well as other violations.
