SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Trespass Warning Issued

On October 1st an officer responded to the 22000 block of Power Rd for a report of a larceny. Upon arrival the complainant advised the officer that her ex-boyfriend had been returning to her home when she was gone and stealing items out of the garage. The woman did not want to press charges for the theft, but wanted the ex-boyfriend advised that he would be arrested for trespassing should he return to her home. The ex-boyfriend was issued a trespass warning.

Fire Alarm

On October 2nd Officers and Engine 1 responded to the Rainbow Restaurant on Farmington Rd. for a report of a fire alarm. Upon arrival officers learned from staff that a contractor had turned off the ventilation hood in order to change a filter. This caused a backup of cooking smoke in the kitchen which resulted in the fire alarm activating. There were no issues on scene.

On October 3rd officers responded to the Grand Tavern Restaurant on Grand River Ave to assist the Farmington Hills Police Department with a fight.
