SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

House Fire

On October 5th officers and Engine 1 responded to a home on Brookdale Dr. for a report of a working structure fire. Upon arrival officers noted that the occupant of the building had exited but that there was smoke emitting out of the back door. Officers were able to extinguish the fire and noted that it was contained to the kitchen. The cause of the fire was a stove burner that had been accidentally left on.

Customer Trouble

On October 6th an officer responded to the Magic Cleaners on Farmington Rd. for a report of a disorderly customer. Upon arrival the officer met with the customer who advised that he came to pick up his dry-cleaning and discovered that one of his shirts had been discolored. The customer demanded to be reimbursed for the shirt and the store owner refused. The officer interviewed the store owner who denied causing any damage to the clothing. The officer attempted to intervene and offer a solution for the two individuals, but neither would agree. The customer was advised that the issue is a civil matter and that he would have to sue the business owner for reimbursement.

Larceny of Wallet

On October 8th an officer responded to the Zap Zone on Grand River Ave for a report of a larceny of a wallet. Upon arrival the officer interviewed the victim and learned that the victim had her wallet returned to her by a staff member but didn't realize that it had been missing. The victim checked her wallet and noticed that all of her money was gone. The victim does not suspect the staff member, but does not know how her wallet had been taken from her or who took the money out of it.
