BREAKING AND ENTERING (11-4162)

On August 8th, at approximately 10:30 a.m., officers were dispatched to Plus Skateboard Shop for a report of a breaking and entering that had just been discovered. An unknown suspect broke out the glass in the entry door and stole a large quantity of merchandise sometime over night. Detectives processed the scene and the investigation is on going.

TRESPASSING (11-4182, 11-4183, 11-4191)

On August 9th, at 10:56 a.m., officers were dispatched to Brookdale Condominiums for a subject sleeping in the hallway. The subject was intoxicated and stated he was kicked out of his mother's condominium and had no place to go. The subject was told to leave the premises or he would face arrest for trespassing. The subject complied.

Less than one hour later, officers again responded to Brookdale Condominiums for another trespassing complaint concerning the same subject. The subject was found on the Brookdale property and arrested. The subject was processed and then submitted to a preliminary breath test (PBT) at the station with a result of .35. The subject was transported to Botsford Hospital.

Note: Afternoon shift responded to Brookdale Condominiums at 5:45 p.m. and arrested the subject again for trespassing. The subject had a blood alcohol level of .37 and was again taken to Botsford Hospital and admitted.

LIGHT POLE COLLAPSE AND WIRES DOWN (11-4192)

On August 9th, officers, along with A Platoon, were dispatched to the report of a telephone pole that had fallen down. The electrical wires from the pole fell on top of a house in the 34000 block of Alta Loma. The wires and pole were removed by DTE without incident.

DISORDERLY PERSONS (11-4251)

On August 12th, at 2:19 p.m., officers were dispatched to the parking lot of Dress Barn for a report of two white males fighting in the parking lot. The subjects were located near Grand River and Grove, separated and interviewed. The subjects were both issued violations for Disorderly Conduct.
