



## WEEKLY REPORT March 5 – March 11, 2012

### **ODOR INVESTIGATION (12-1013)**

A resident on Heritage Lane called to report an odor of natural gas in the area. Department members responded and detected an odor of natural gas. Personnel stood by until Consumers Energy arrived on the scene and determined that the odor was from a faulty furnace.

### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED THIRD OFFENSE/DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED/PROPERTY INJURY ACCIDENT (12-1020)**

On March 4<sup>th</sup>, a female was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) Third Offense Causing an Injury Accident, and Driving While License Suspended. A crash on Hawthorne at Nine Mile occurred when an intoxicated female ran a stop sign on southbound Hawthorne at Nine Mile. The suspect vehicle was struck in the side and then struck another vehicle head on. Two subjects had minor injuries and sought medical attention later that day. The “at fault” female was given sobriety tests and a preliminary breath test (PBT .24%), which she failed. The female was arrested for OWI and refused a blood test to check for alcohol. The subject was then transported to the hospital where a blood draw was conducted subsequent to a court ordered search warrant.

### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED (12-1077)**

On March 9<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 3:00 a.m., an officer stopped a vehicle for violation of the “No Turn on Red” sign at Grand River and Orchard Lake. Upon stopping the vehicle, the driver admitted to drinking alcohol on the night in question. The driver failed field sobriety tests and a preliminary breath test. The driver was arrested and transported to the station. The driver submitted to the datamaster with a result of .12. The driver was held till sober.

### **FELONIOUS ASSAULT – LATE REPORT (12-1101)**

Victim came into the station to file a report on a Felonious Assault that occurred on February 1, 2012 in the parking lot of TJ Maxx. The victim, whom is a loss prevention officer at TJ Maxx, reported he had been having problems with another female employee. The victim stated when the female employee’s boyfriend arrived to pick her up, the victim went into the parking lot where the male occupant of the vehicle lifted his shirt to reveal a semi-auto handgun he had in his possession. The victim stated that the suspect made threatening statements. The victim stated he did not file a report on the date of the incident, because he was told that TJ Maxx was doing an investigation internally.

**OPEN HOUSE PARTY/MINOR IN POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL (12-1112)**

On March 10<sup>th</sup>, at 10:48 p.m., the afternoon shift was dispatched to the 21000 block of Larkspur for the report of a house party involving minors. Officers arrived to find a large group of teens inside and around the home. When it was learned that the police were at the party, a large number of the teens fled. A subsequent investigation found that the party was hosted by a seventeen year old male whose parents were out of town. The host was cited for open house party and minor in possession of alcohol.

**OPEN DOORS (12-1119 & 12-1120)**

While completing business checks on March 11<sup>th</sup>, midnight officers found two businesses that had doors that were not secured. The businesses at 34705 Grand River and 34425 Grand River were secured and their owners were notified.
