



## WEEKLY REPORT May 28 – June 3, 2012

### **HIT AND RUN PROPERTY DAMAGE ACCIDENT (PDA)**

On May 28<sup>th</sup>, officers responded to the area of Macomb and Cass regarding an unoccupied parked vehicle which was struck by a green pick up. Witnesses reported the green pick up to leave westbound on Oakland from Cass. An area check yielded negative results.

### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED SECOND OFFENSE**

On May 28<sup>th</sup>, dispatch received a call from a citizen who reported an intoxicated driver in a green pick up westbound on Freedom from Orchard Lake Road. An officer located the vehicle at Freedom and Farmington Road. The vehicle matched the description from the previous hit and run accident. The officer stopped the vehicle in the 7-Eleven parking lot near Nine Mile and Farmington Road. It was determined the vehicle was not involved in the PDA. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the interior of the vehicle. The driver admitted to drinking six beers at the Park Motel in Farmington Hills. The driver failed field sobriety tests with a PBT of .11(8). The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI). The driver had a previous OWI in 2009 out of Farmington. The driver submitted to a breath test at the station with a result of .13 and .13. The driver was held until sober. A warrant request will be submitted to the Oakland County Prosecutor's Office for OWI II.

### **STORM DAMAGE**

On May 28<sup>th</sup>, at 11:40 p.m., a brief but strong storm came through the Farmington area. During this storm, Farmington residents experienced power outages and damage to vehicles and homes. A home on Marblehead, and two vehicles on Violet sustained damage when large limbs fell. Maple Street was blocked for much of the day by a large tree until it could be removed by the Farmington Department of Public Works.

### **STORM DAMAGE**

On May 29<sup>th</sup>, officers responded to several calls regarding fallen trees on parked vehicles and blocking roadways in the area of Floral Street. Officers also located several wires down at the Farmington Aquatic Club and on Maple Street. The areas were blocked off and the residents advised. Detroit Edison was contacted.

### **STORM DAMAGE**

On May 29<sup>th</sup>, at 1:00 p.m., an officer responded to an Orchard Lake Road residence where a tree limb had fallen on a pickup and caused damage to the roof, hood and a window. This was as a result of the storm the previous night.

### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED/OPEN INTOXICANTS IN A MOTOR VEHICLE**

On May 29<sup>th</sup>, at 7:16 p.m., an officer was dispatched to the report of a possible intoxicated driver in the area of eastbound Grand River, near Drake. The officer located the suspect vehicle as it approached downtown. The officer observed the vehicle driving consistently with what the reporting party described and stopped the vehicle. The officer made contact and noted that the driver smelled of intoxicants and admitted to have been drinking. The officer administered field sobriety test and gave the driver a PBT. The driver had a blood alcohol level of .10(4) and had an open bottle of wine in the vehicle. The driver was arrested and lodged in the Farmington jail.

### **LARCENY FROM AUTO**

A resident of Kensington Manor Apartments reported the theft of a laptop and debit card. Items were stolen from her vehicle over a three day period. She is not sure where the theft occurred as the vehicle had been at numerous locations in various cities during the three days.

### **FAMILY TROUBLE**

On May 31<sup>st</sup>, at 3:00 p.m., officers responded on a family trouble, boyfriend/girlfriend in a dispute. Officers mediated and transported the male to a motel.

### **MINOR IN POSSESSION**

On June 1<sup>st</sup>, a seventeen year old entered this department to participate in court mandated PBT testing. An officer administered the PBT with a result of .07(0). The subject initially denied consuming alcohol but then admitted to having several beers at a party on May 31<sup>st</sup>. The subject was issued a citation for Minor in Possession by Consumption. The subject's parents and probationary officer were notified of the incident.

### **SKATEBOARDING/OBSTRUCTING AN OFFICER**

On June 1<sup>st</sup>, at 2:45 p.m., an officer responded to Grand River and Farmington on a report of a subject skateboarding in the intersection and interfering with traffic. It was also learned the subject had already been warned. An officer made contact with the adult male who attempted to flee. The subject was arrested for obstructing a police officer.

### **OPERATING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS**

On June 1<sup>st</sup>, at 8:18 p.m., an officer was alerted to a reckless driver traveling eastbound on Grand River from Drake Road. The officer observed the vehicle weaving back and forth. The officer stopped the vehicle and made contact with the driver. During the subsequent investigation, the officer learned that the driver had not been drinking, but had taken Xanax. The officer administered field sobriety test, which the driver failed. The driver was arrested for Operating Under the Influence of Drugs. The officer transported the driver to the Farmington police station where a blood draw was conducted. The driver was lodged in the Farmington jail.

### **MALICIOUS MISCHIEF**

On June 1<sup>st</sup>, at 10:58 p.m. in the 21000 block of Birchwood, an unknown suspect(s) egged a house. They also poured syrup on the porch and Beefaroni on a vehicle.

**LARCENY IN BUILDING**

On June 2<sup>nd</sup>, at 2:40 p.m., officers responded to Merle Norman where a male had stolen checks from the back office and fled on foot from the business. Officers checked the area for the suspect and processed the scene for evidence.
