WEEKLY REPORT

December 16 - 22, 2013

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED THIRD OFFENSE

On December 16th, at 2:30 a.m., an officer stopped a vehicle on westbound M5 near Farmington Road for drifting outside of its lane. Upon speaking to the driver the officer noted an odor of alcohol coming from the driver of the vehicle and the driver admitted to consuming one drink earlier in the night. The driver was requested to perform field sobriety tests and same complied. The driver failed field sobriety tests and a preliminary breath test (PBT) .166. The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (third offense) and transported to the station. The driver submitted two breath samples upon request at the station, .18 and .17. The driver was processed and housed awaiting arraignment.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED THIRD OFFENSE

On December 16th, at 9:28 p.m., an officer came upon a crash at Nine Mile and Farmington Road. A subject driving a black Ford SUV ran a red light on eastbound Nine Mile at Farmington Road. The suspect SUV struck a northbound vehicle which caused the SUV to lose control and strike a stopped vehicle for westbound Nine Mile traffic. The SUV then careened off of the stopped vehicle and struck the control box for the traffic signals over Nine Mile and Farmington Road. Officers and CEMS tended to the injured victims while sobriety tests were administered to the at fault driver of the SUV. The officer noted a strong odor of intoxicants on the driver's breath. The officer administered field sobriety tests and determined that the suspect was under the influence of either prescription pain killers and/or alcohol. The at fault driver refused a PBT and was subsequently arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) 3rd offense. The suspect was then transported to Botsford Hospital where a blood draw was conducted subsequent to a search warrant. The case was turned over to the Oakland County Prosecutor for review and charges.

ATTEMPT BREAKING AND ENTERING

On December 19th an officer was dispatched to the 22000 block of Power Road for the report of a suspicious circumstance. The officer learned that sometime between 5:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. an unknown suspect attempted to gain entry into an occupied home. The suspect opened an unlocked bathroom window and moved a shower curtain. At some point the suspect was alerted to a possible occupant inside the home; at which point the subject fled

the area of foot. There were fresh foot prints in the newly melting snow. At this time there is no suspect information.

FAIL TO DISCLOSE CONCEALED WEAPON OF A POLICE OFFICER

On December 21st, at 12:40 a.m., an officer stopped a vehicle near M5 and Grand River for improper lane use. The officer made contact with the driver and obtained a driver's license. Upon running the driver through LEIN/SOS, the officer discovered that the driver had a permit to carry a concealed weapon. The officer made contact with the driver again and asked him if he had a weapon on his person or in the car. The driver stated he did and that he had forgot to tell the officer about it. The driver was issued a violation for failure to disclose his concealed weapon to a police officer and was released.
