WEEKLY RECAP

August 17 – August 23, 2015

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

On August 17th at approximately 11:48 AM a woman came into the police department inquiring about the arrest of her husband. The woman appeared to be heavily intoxicated so the civilian staff alerted road patrol officers as the woman left the building. An Officer on patrol observed the woman drive away from the police department so the officer made an investigatory traffic stop. The woman failed several sobriety exams and was subsequently arrested for operating while intoxicated. The woman was transported to the Farmington Jail where she submitted to a Datamaster Breath Test with a result of a .35 BAC. The woman had been arrested by this department on 08/16/2015 for the same offense. The woman was housed at the Farmington Jail.

SUSPICIOUS PERSONS

On August 17th at approximately 3:28 PM officers were dispatched to a report of several teens smoking marijuana at a residence on the 22800 block of Floral. Upon arrival officers located the teens, but did not find any marijuana on them. A search of the backyard produced evidence that marijuana had been smoked in the past. The teens' parents were advised.

POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA

On August 18th at approximately 12:39 AM an officer conducting an apartment check at an apartment complex on Drakeshire Ln stopped a vehicle for having a defective equipment violation. Further investigation revealed an odor of marijuana in the vehicle as well as evidence of narcotics use. The officer conducted a search of the vehicle based on probable cause and located 42.8 grams of marijuana. The driver was arrested for being in possession of marijuana. The driver also had a suspended license and several warrants for his arrest out of other police agencies, including a felony warrant for delivery of narcotics. The driver was housed at the Farmington Jail.

IDENTITY THEFT

On August 18th at approximately 11:07 AM a Drake Heights resident came into this police department to report that she was a victim of an identity theft. The resident advised that an

unknown person had opened charge cards in her name and charged over \$3,000 to them. The case was forwarded to the detective bureau.

IDENTITY THEFT

On August 18th at approximately 2:15 PM a Grand River Ave resident came into this police department to report that an unknown person had charged approximately \$90 to his Visa Card. The report was forwarded to the detective bureau for further investigation.

SOLICIT WITHOUT A PERMIT

On August 18th at approximately 3 PM an officer was dispatched to a report of door to door solicitor on the 24000 block of Farmington Rd. Upon arrival the officer located a subject that was going door to door soliciting for AT&T. The man did not have a permit to solicit and was cited for soliciting without a permit.

OUTDOOR FENCE FIRE

On August 18th at approximately 7:16 PM officers and Engine 3 were dispatched to a residence on Tall Oaks Ct for a report of a house fire. Upon arrival officers learned that a wooden fence had been on fire but a nearby neighbor had extinguished the fire with a hose. Officers learned that the homeowner's adult son had been smoking near the area earlier and that his discarded cigarettes had set the old wooden fence on fire.

URINATING IN PUBLIC

On August 19th at approximately 1:53 PM a Farmington Hills Police Sergeant observed a suspect urinating on a building in the area of Grand River and Lilac. Farmington Officers responded and cited the man for urinating in public.

HOME INVASION

On August 20th at approximately 3:38 PM officers were dispatched to the 33600 block of State St for a possible home invasion. Upon arrival officers learned that the residents were gone from the home for approximately 2 hours. When the residents returned they discovered that their rear door had been forced in. The residents advised that nothing was missing that they know of.

ATTEMPT UTTERING AND PUBLISHING

On August 20th at approximately 3:59 PM officers were dispatched to a credit union on the 31700 block of Grand River Ave for a report of a female attempting to pass a bad check. Upon arrival officers learned that the woman had fled the scene in a black Jeep Grand Cherokee after attempting to pass a fraudulent check at the drive through. Officers checked the area but could not locate the woman. The case was forwarded to the detective bureau for further investigation.

NEVER ACQUIRED DRIVER'S LICENSE

On August 21st at approximately 1:25 PM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Power for an equipment violation. Further investigation revealed that the driver did not have a driver's license and had a felony warrant for fraud out of a neighboring

police agency. The woman was arrested for never acquiring a driver's license and was housed at the Farmington Jail.

DROVE WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED

On August 21st at approximately 6:46 PM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Farmington Rd for disobeying the no turn on red sign. Further investigation revealed that the driver had 12 suspensions on his driver's license and 7 warrants for his arrest. The driver was arrested for driving on a suspended license and housed at the Farmington Jail.

DROVE WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED

On August 22nd at approximately 7:40 AM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Grove for speeding. Further investigation revealed that the driver had a suspended license and a warrant for his arrest. The driver was arrested for driving on a suspended license and was housed at the Farmington Jail.

CIVIL MATTER

On August 22nd at approximately 6:59 PM an officer was dispatched to an apartment on the 33300 block of Kingslane Ct for a report of a possible larceny. Upon arrival the officer learned from the victim that he had met a homeless man and offered to let the man eat and shower at the victim's home. The victim loaned the man his iPod so that the man could listen to music. The man never returned to the apartment so the victim filed the complaint.

OPERATE WHILE INTOXICATED

On August 23rd at approximately 4:14 AM officers were dispatched to the area of Farmington Rd and Nine Mile for a report of a motorist passed out while stopped at the intersection. Upon arrival officers learned from the complainant that the vehicle had been sitting at the traffic light for approximately 10 minutes. Officers noted that both the driver and the passenger appeared to be sleeping and that the vehicle's gear was still in drive. Officers had to pound on the windows to wake the occupants. Officers noted that the vehicle had an odor of intoxicants and burnt marijuana. The driver exhibited signs of intoxication and failed several sobriety exams. The driver was arrested for operating while intoxicated. An inventory search of the driver's vehicle revealed 1.6 grams of marijuana and a marijuana pipe. The driver was transported to the Farmington Jail where she submitted to a Datamaster Breath Test with a result of a .08 BAC. The driver was housed at the Farmington Jail until sober and was cited for OWI, possession of Marijuana and possession of marijuana paraphernalia.

Note: Officers had responded to 15 medical calls this week and 6 traffic crashes.
