WEEKLY RECAP

December 11th, 2017 through December 17th, 2017

DWLS, Warrant and OWI Arrests

Between December 11th and December 17th, FDPS personnel made four misdemeanor driver license related and warrant arrests and one OWI arrest as a result of conducting proactive traffic enforcement.

Narcotic Paraphernalia

On 12/11/2017 at approximately 2144 hours an officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for a red light violation at Grand River and Power. The officer detected an odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. The 24 year old female driver denied possessing marijuana but admitted to having a marijuana pipe and grinder in the vehicle. The pipe and grinder were confiscated and the vehicle searched with negative results. The driver was cited for narcotic paraphernalia and released with a citation.

ID theft

On 12/12/2017 at 1927 hours officers were dispatched to the Tile Shop located at 37025 Grand River on a fraud in progress. Upon arrival, officers learned two male suspects, ages 26 and 30, attempted to purchase \$2,392.76 in items with a fraudulent credit card. The name on the order and credit card belonged to a third party residing out of state. The manager became suspicious and contacted the out of state resident. The out of state resident denied placing the order and was a victim of identity theft. The manager then cancelled the order. The suspects left the business in a U-Haul which was stopped by officers on M-5. The two suspects were arrested and warrants were subsequently obtained from the Oakland County Prosecutors Office on charges of ID theft and false pretenses among others.

Marijuana Possession

On 12/15/17 at 2:00 AM, a vehicle was stopped on M-5 and Farmington for a defective tail light. The officer detected an odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle and observed in plain view a marijuana blunt in the center console. A search of the vehicle yielded marijuana and an open bottle of Hennessy Cognac. The marijuana was confiscated and the liquor poured out in front of the patrol camera. The 38 year old driver was arrested for marijuana possession and DWLS. The vehicle was impounded. The driver was housed and cited for marijuana possession, open intoxicants MV and DWLS.

Narcotics

On 12/16/2017 an officer stopped a vehicle at Grand River and Lakeway at 2:00 AM for a defective tail light. The officer detected an odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. A search of the vehicle located 4 Adderall capsules in a backpack belonging to the driver, 43 Clonazepam pills and marijuana in the driver's purse. The 24 year old female driver did not have a prescription for the pills or a medical marijuana card. The driver was arrested for narcotics and marijuana possession. The vehicle was impounded. The driver was processed and released pending a toxicology exam of the pills by the Oakland County Sheriff's Office.

Narcotic Paraphernalia

On 12/17/2017 at approximately 2310 hours an officer stopped a vehicle at Grand River and Power for speeding. The officer detected an odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. A search of the vehicle yielded three marijuana pipes and a marijuana bong in the trunk. The 19 year old male driver was cited and released. The confiscated items were destroyed at this PD per policy.
