WEEKLY RECAP

June 12, 2017 thru June 18, 2017

Marijuana / Narcotic Equipment

On June 12th an Officer stopped a vehicle in the area of Orchard Lake and Shiawassee for running a red light. While talking to the driver, the Officer could smell the odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. The Officer searched the vehicle and found approximately 7 grams of marijuana, a glass pipe and a number of small plastic containers with marijuana residue. The driver was arrest, transported to jail and issued a citation.

OWI (High BAC)

On June 13th Officers responded to the area of Eight Mile and Farmington for a report of a two vehicle crash. Officers learned from the other driver and witnesses that the at-fault driver appeared to be highly intoxicated and walked off on foot. Officers found a highly intoxicated female matching the description provided by witnesses, a short distance away from the scene. The female admitted to driving the crashed vehicle, which had rear ended another vehicle on Eight Mile Road. The driver performed field sobriety evaluations and a PBT that resulted .15(5). The driver was arrested for OWI and transported to jail where they registered a .17 on the Datamaster.

Aggravated Assault

On June 15th Officers responded to the area of Meadowlark and Farmington for a report of a traffic altercation that resulted in a black male subject brandishing a gun and fleeing the area. The subject was described to be driving a black Chevy Camaro convertible at a high rate of speed in the neighborhood and when confronted by a concerned resident. After exchanging words the subject lifted his shirt displaying a black semi-automatic handgun and told the victim "you don't want any of this". Officers canvassed the area and as a result developed a possible suspect. The case has been assigned to Detectives for further follow up.

Attempt Larceny – Personal Property from Vehicle(s)

On June 16th Officers responded to the area of Ten Mile between Farmington and Power Roads after hearing a radio dispatch of two white males seen breaking into a vehicle on Raphael north of Ten Mile. Officers located four vehicles in the area that were found unlocked and appeared to have been rummaged through. Nothing was reported stolen at the time of the reports, nor was anything reporting stolen in the Farmington Hills case.

OWI (High BAC)

On June 17th an Officer stopped a vehicle on westbound M5 and Grand River after following and observing it driving erratically, reaching speeds of 104 mph before stopping the vehicle. While speaking with the confused driver, who admitted they were coming from a bar on Telegraph, the Officer noted the strong odor of an intoxicants coming from the driver. The driver performed field sobriety evaluations and a PBT that resulted .17(4). The driver was arrested for OWI and transported to jail.

Soliciting without a Permit

On May 17th an Officer responded to the Warner subdivision for a report of a person soliciting the sale of magazines. The Officer located a subject matching the description of the suspect on Hayden talking to a resident. The Officer determined that the subject did not have a permit to solicit door to door in Farmington and subsequently issued the subject a citation for the violation.

Possess Marijuana

On June 17th a Sergeant stopped a vehicle on Eight Mile near Chesley for a cracked windshield. While talking to the driver, the Sergeant noted the smell of marijuana from the interior of the vehicle and subsequently searched the vehicle. As a result of the search the Sergeant found approximately 11 grams of marijuana, which the driver stated was for personal use, but denied having a medical marijuana card. The driver was arrested, transported to jail and issued a citation for the violation.
