WEEKLY RECAP

November 13, 2017 through November 19, 2017

DWLS, Warrant and OWI Arrests

Between November 13th and November 19th, FDPS personnel made ten (10) misdemeanor driver license related and warrant arrests, and two (2) operating while intoxicated arrests as a result of conducting proactive traffic enforcement.

Retail Fraud 3rd degree

On 11/13/17 at approximately 6:00 p.m. officers were dispatched to a local hardware store on a retail fraud. Upon arrival, officers learned two W/M suspects were observed on surveillance cameras switching the price tags on various construction equipment. The suspects then paid for the items using a credit card. An officer was able to identify one of the suspects via the name on the credit card. Detectives subsequently identified the second suspect and interviewed them both. One suspect (26 years of age) admitted to switching price tags and was arrested and cited for Retail Fraud. The other suspect (27 years of age) was released after it was learned he had no knowledge of the crime.

Car Stolen/Returned

On 11/15/2017 officers were dispatched to Farmington auto care business regarding an auto theft. Upon arrival, officers learned a recently repaired vehicle was stolen from the parking lot at approximately. The vehicle was subsequently located at a Livonia Meijer's store. The owner of the vehicle refused to press charges and the vehicle was turned over to him.

Weapons Violation

On 11/15/2017 at approximately 6:30 p.m. an officer stopped to help the driver of a disabled vehicle located on the shoulder of M-5 and Farmington Road. The officer observed in plain view a black 9mm handgun in the interior pocket of the driver's side door. The 26 year old driver did not possess a concealed pistol license. The handgun was confiscated and the driver arrested. The report was forwarded to the Oakland County Prosecutor and an arrest warrant was subsequently obtained.

OWI-2nd Offense

On 11/17/2017 at 8:30 p.m. an officer observed an older female exiting a local liquor store. The female was carrying a brown paper bag and unsteady on her feet. She entered a vehicle and struck the curb as she was exiting the parking lot onto Orchard Lake Road. The officer also observed the vehicle to make a left turn onto W/B Shiawassee in front of

oncoming traffic. The vehicle was stopped and the 60 year old driver identified. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the vehicle. The driver failed field sobriety tests with a Preliminary Breath Test of .16(8). The driver was arrested for OWI and the vehicle impounded. The driver agreed to take a breath test at the station with a result of .19 and .19. The driver had a previous OWI conviction. The report was forwarded to the OCPO on charges of OWI II offense.

Marijuana Possession

On 11/19/2017 at approximately 1:00 a.m. officers were dispatched to the area of Conroy Court on shots fired. While patrolling the area, an officer observed a suspicious vehicle. The officer made contact with the two occupants. The officer detected a strong odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. The occupants admitted to smoking marijuana in the vehicle. The vehicle was searched and loose marijuana was located in a plastic container in the center console of the vehicle. The 28 year old female passenger admitted ownership of the marijuana. The passenger was arrested and cited for marijuana possession. The report of gunshots in the area was determined to be unfounded.
