#### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

##### Receive and Conceal Stolen Vehicle

On June 15<sup>th</sup> an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Orchard Lake for speeding. Further investigation revealed that the vehicle had been reported stolen out of Indiana. The driver of the vehicle never had a driver’s license and had a criminal history of receiving stolen property. The driver was arrested for receiving and concealing the stolen vehicle as well as never acquiring a driver’s license. The case was submitted to the Oakland County Prosecutors Office for a warrant.

##### Identity Theft

On June 15<sup>th</sup> a Valley View Circle resident came into the police department to report that an unknown person had attempted to open a credit account in his name with Comenity Bank. The victim further learned that someone had opened an account with TCF Bank in his name. The victim does not know who opened the accounts and the report was forwarded to the detective bureau for further investigation.
