SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Fire Alarm

On November 20th officers and Engine 1 responded to a residence on Heritage Ln. for a report of a fire alarm. Upon arrival officers learned that the homeowner had forgotten about bacon grease left on the stove that had activated the alarm when smoking. There was no damage to the building.

Suspicious Circumstance

On November 21st a Prospect Ave. resident reported at the front desk that she believes she had been scammed. The complainant advised that she sold a wheelbarrow on Facebook Marketplace and had placed the wheelbarrow in her driveway after instructing the buyer to place the money in her mailbox. Upon returning home from being out, the complainant noticed that the wheelbarrow was gone, but that there was no money in her mailbox. The complainant contacted police and reported the incident. Officers contacted the buyer who asserts that he did leave the money and was willing to take a lie detector test to prove it. The complainant was advised that she would have to take the buyer to court over the incident.
