SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Suspicious Circumstance

On January 25th an officer responded to a residence on the 31000 block of Shiawassee for a possible larceny in a building. Upon arrival the officer spoke with the complainant who advised that several days earlier the complainant and her husband had a couple of friends spend the night. The complainant advised that her female friend had become extremely intoxicated and had left the home with her boyfriend. A couple of days later the complainant noticed that her outside camera had been moved and several toys had been stolen from her son's room. The complainant suspects that her friend stole the items. The officer contacted the friend who advised that she denies stealing the toys and advised that she was being unjustly accused of the theft because she had accused the complainant's husband of inappropriately touching her when she was 16 years old. The complainant has no evidence that the friend stole the toys.

Credit Card Fraud

On January 28th an officer responded to a residence on Grand River Ave for a fraud report. Upon arrival the officer learned from the victim that she was contacted by her bank and advised that charges to her credit card were made in California and North Carolina. The total charges to the victim's account were over \$1,300. The bank cancelled the card and will not make the victim responsible for the charges.
