### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### Wires Down

On February 16<sup>th</sup> officers responded to the 32000 block of Chesley Dr. for a report of a truck boom striking overhead wires. Upon arrival officers learned that a construction truck with its boom fully extended had driven under some overhead wires, pulling them down as the truck drove down the street. Officers turned the scene over to DTE Energy.

#### Hit and Run Crash

On February 17<sup>th</sup> an officer responded to the area of Grand River Ave and Shiawassee for a hit and run crash. Upon arrival the officer learned from the victim that he had been driving on Shiawassee when he was struck by another vehicle.
