

Going Away to College in the Fall? Still want to **VOTE**?



- You must be registered to vote by the following dates:
 - July 9, 2018 for August Primary
 - October 9, 2018 for November General
- You must expect to be absent from the community in which you are registered for the entire time the polls are open on Election Day.
- You need to find or request an **ABSENTEE APPLICATION TO VOTE** for the election you will be absent for.
 - Stop in to your Clerk's Office before you leave for college - or -
 - Print one from the designated election page found on your city's website - or -
 - Print one from the State of Michigan website - or -
 - Call the City Clerk's office and request one
- Complete the application and send it – SIGNED – to your City Clerk's office. Make sure that your name and address are PRINTED somewhere on the application, please.
- Upon receipt of your signed application, a ballot will be mailed out to you.
- Vote your choices on the ballot, put the ballot in the open secrecy sleeve, then insert that sleeve into the envelope without the address window, seal it up, sign in the red box, and mail back to the City Clerk.

Please be mindful of how long each operation will take through the Post Office and request and return your ballot as soon as you can!
