City of Farmington **9 Mile & Floral Water Main Repair Construction & Water Main Shutdown Notice**

It is anticipated that construction of removing and replacing a portion of the water main along 9 Mile Road and Floral Street will begin on Thursday, October 15, 2020 (weather permitting). The water main will also have to be shut down on October 15th. The shut down will start at 8:00 AM on Thursday. The shutoff will have a minimal impact to local residences and businesses. Please be advised that adverse weather can effect the schedule. The limits of this project extend from the alleyway just north of Grand River to Floral Street.

Driveway access to all residences will be maintained throughout the duration of the project. For the duration of the project, the road will be closed and a detour route will need to be taken. It is anticipated that it will take approximately 2 weeks (weather permitting) to complete the water main replacement. Additional information will be provided to all affected residents at a later date.

Please keep children and pets away from the construction operation. Construction activities, and the associated equipment that goes with it, is attractive to small children and can be dangerous. Please keep children away from all of the equipment and areas where work crews will be present.
